The children can enjoy some water fun, running in and out of the sprinklers, balloon toss, water tables and so much more.

Parent Tip

2024-2025 School Year

On August 19th we begin a new school year with the children moving to their new classes. You will receive information about your child's new teacher and classroom on August 12th, if you have completed the 2023-2024 Registration Forms on Playground. This way our records are current and up to date. These forms will be on Playground by Friday, August 5th.

Day Care parents DO NOT have to pay another registration fee.

To kick off July, the theme will be America the Beautiful, Cooking, Fairytales, Music/Art, and Olympics.

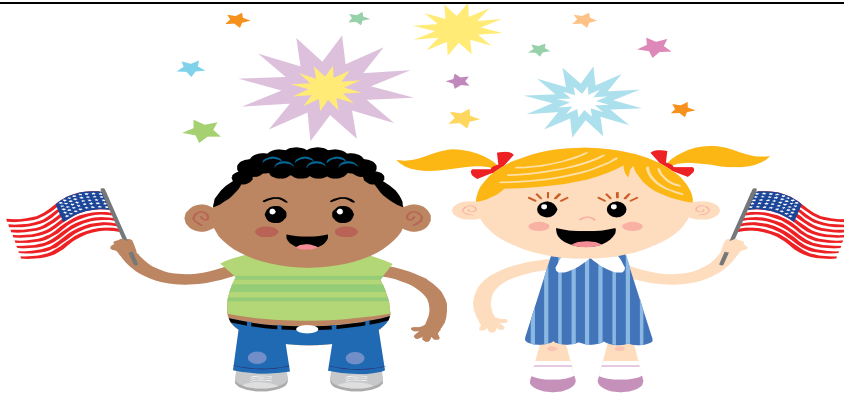
