

Monthly Report for Church Council

1. Accomplishments for this month

- a. The 2nd Mission Weekend was a success: 11 students and 10 adults participated. Earned \$818 from the Car Wash Fundraiser and the Trustees donated \$182, making it to \$1,000! It will be used to purchase necessary items for the Youth Center.
- b. The Youth Council interviewed and hired a Youth Worship Intern: Riley Miller. He is recruiting youth band members. The Youth Band will lead music every first Sunday of the month at the PACK Night gathering (Worship Day).

2. Specific items of celebration/concern

- a. The PACK AM (Sunday School at 10 - 10:50 AM) and The PACK Night (Sunday at 6 - 7:30 PM) will resume on August 29. We will use the Sanctuary of the OCB (the Youth Center) until we will be not able to do so due to renovation of the upstairs.
- b. We will require all (students and adult leaders and parents if they stay) to wear a mask indoors at all the PACK gatherings by following the CDC guidelines and the practices of the public schools in the community. (Also, the rising 6th graders are 11 years old who aren't vaccinated yet.)

3. Objectives for the next month.

- a. Old and New adult volunteers are asked to go through background check, unless they did it within three years, and they will get a leader training (especially on our church's "Children Protection Policy") during the September Youth Council meeting.

- a. Pray for volunteers to fill needed positions.
- b. Pray for youth to turn out and engage in Sunday School.
